AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2, S. 1994, GRANTING
PATERNITY LEAVE, EMERGENCY LEAVE AND BIRTHDAY
LEAVE TO ALL PROVINCIAL PAID OFFICIALS AND
EMPLOYEES OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF BENGUET

EXPLANATORY NOTE

WHEREAS, replying to the request of Hon. Jaime Paul B. Panganiban, Provincial Governor, Benguet, for authority to implement Ordinance No. 2 dated February 21, 1994 passed by this Body granting paternity, emergency and birthday leave privileges to all officials and employees of the Benguet Provincial Government, the Civil Service Commission, Quezon City, stated among others, in its Resolution No. 94-4014 dated July 26, 1994, that the paternity, emergency and birthday leave benefits should not be considered additional leave benefits but the grantees thereof are merely considered excused from reporting to the office and not considered or marked absent for the period of the leave applied for and enjoyed;

WHEREAS, there is need to amend Ordinance No. 2, dated February 21, 1994, to embody the above-condition;

BENGUET IN SESSION ASSEMBLED THAT:**


Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 2, s. 1994 is hereby amended by adding a sentence to wit:

"The leave benefits should not be considered additional leave benefits but the grantees thereof are merely considered excused from reporting to the office and not considered or marked absent for the period of the leave applied for and enjoyed."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991.


