PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 96-19

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PERSONS FROM THROWING OR DUMPING TRASH OR GARBAGE, INCLUDING VEGETABLE REFUSE, ALONG THE NATIONAL HIGHWAYS OR ROADS OF BENGUET PROVINCE INCLUDING ALONG THEIR CANALS, DITCHES, AND CREEKS ADJACENT OR NEAR THEM AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

EXPLANATORY NOTE

"WHEREAS, it is a practice of the travelling public, including vegetable dealers and farmers, passing through national roads in Benguet to throw or dump their trash or garbage and vegetable refuse on the road ways and to its canals, ditches, or creeks adjacent or near it. It has been observed that the major national roads in Benguet are the ones mostly affected like the Halsema Highway, Marcos Highway, Kennon Road, and the Quirino Highway. Garbages were also observed along secondary national roads like the Acop-Kapangan-Kibungan Road, the Benguet-Nueva Vizcaya Road, the Gurel-Bokod-Kabayan-Buguias Road and other roads. Some of these roads or its ditches are even being utilized as garbage areas of some barangays traversed by the roads;

WHEREAS, this rampant practice causes pollution of the province's waterways producing also foul odors along the road and clogging the road canals and creeks. The unsightly condition evokes bad comments from commuters and tourists passing through these national roads;

WHEREAS, in order, therefor, to maintain cleanliness and order along our scenic national roads, this ordinance is being proposed for approval by the August body.

As proposed by Hon. Samson C. Paran and Hon. Fernando M. Aritao and on motion duly seconded,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN OF BENGUET IN SESSION ASSEMBLED THAT:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to throw or dump trash or garbage, including vegetable refuse, along any part of the national roads or highways, including their canals, ditches, or creek adjacent or near them, in the Province of Benguet.

Section 2. Any person found violating this ordinance shall suffer the following penalties;

First Offense	fine	of	P50.00
Second Offense.	fine	of	P100.00
Third and subsequent Offenses	fine of	P200.00 or imprisonment of not more than 5 days or both at the discretion of the court.	

Section 3. All the municipal mayors of Benguet are hereby authorized to implement this ordinance in their respective localities where there are national or provincial roads and fines collected by them shall redound to their respective municipal funds.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991.
