PROVINCIAL TAX ORDINANCE NO. 97-41

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND FIXING THE RATE OF SECRETARY'S FEES, VETERINARIAN FEES AND CHARGES, RENTAL FEES FOR GYMNASIUM, MUSEUM ARTIFACTS, CHAIRS, TABLES, POTTED FLOWERING AND ORNAMENTAL PLANTS IN THE PROVINCE OF BENGUET, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 1 AND 2 OF ARTICLE A, CHAPTER IV; INSERTING ARTICLE D TO CHAPTER IV; INSERTING SUBSECTION a-1 TO SECTION 1 OF ARTICLE A, CHAPTER V; AND THE INSERTION OF ARTICLE C TO CHAPTER V OF PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 01, S. 1993 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "AN ORDINANCE CODIFYING THE REVENUE ORDINANCE OF BENGUET PROVINCE".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

WHEREAS, presented to this Body for favorable consideration is a proposal from the Provincial Finance Committee introducing amendments to Provincial Ordinance No. 01-93 as follows: 1) Amending Sections 1 and 2 of Article A, Chapter IV relative to the rates of Secretary's fees; Inserting a new article, ARTICLE D to Chapter V relative to Veterinary Fees and Charges; Inserting Sub-section a-1 to Section 1, Article A of Chapter V relative to rentals for the use of the provincial gymnasium, museum artifacts, chairs, tables and potted flowering and ornamental plants.

WHEREAS, the rates herein recommended was based on Administrative Order No. 94-03 and 94-09 dated January 21, 1994 and January 14, 1994, respectively, of the Honorable Provincial Governor and the recommendations of Provincial Treasurer Mauricio B. Ambanloc; Provincial Assessor Erlinda A. Estepa;

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN OF BENGUET IN
SESSION ASSEMBLED, THAT THE FOLLOWING AMENDMENTS TO THE PROVINCIAL
ORDINANCE NO. 01, S. 1993; OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE BENGUET PROVINCE
REVENUE CODE BE ADOPTED:**

Section 1. Section 1 of Article A, Chapter IV of the Provincial
Ordinance No. 01, s. 1993 shall be amended and shall read as
follows:

"Section 1. Imposition of fees. Every person requesting for
copies of official records and documents from any of the
offices of the Provincial Government of Benguet, including
hospitals owned and operated by the Province shall pay the
following fees:

- h. For annotation of mortgage sheriff's certificate of sale, Extra-Judicial foreclosure, Court order/decision, bail bond, notice of lis pendens/adverse claims, per copy of instrument and ARP P 10.00

- i. For cancellation of mortgage, etc., per copy of instrument and ARP P 10.00

- j. For blue printing per copy P 30.00

- k. For blue printing per copy with certification P 40.00

Section 2. Section 2 of Article A, Chapter IV shall be amended and shall read as follows:

"Section 2. Exemption. The fees herein imposed under this Article shall not be collected for copies and certifications furnished to other bureaus, agencies, offices or branches of the government for official business.

Section 3. Chapter IV shall be amended by the insertion of ARTICLE D to read as follows:

ARTICLE D. Veterinarian Fees and Charges

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS. When used in this Article:

(a) **Veterinary Health Certificate** - a certification from a Veterinarian that animal is free from communicable diseases. This is usually required in shipping of livestock from one place to another.

(b) **Artificial Insemination** - refers to the technique in which semen is collected from the male and introduced into the female reproductive tract in the proper time with the aid of instruments which causes pregnancy.

(c) **Natural Breeding** - refers to the breeding of "in heat" female animals brought to the Kabayan Breeding station.

(d) **Fee** - refers to the charge fixed by law or ordinance for services rendered by a public office.

(e) **Charges** - refers to certain amounts collected in exchange of a certain commodity from the office of the Provincial Veterinary as was fixed by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan.

SECTION 2. IMPOSITION OF FEES AND CHARGES. There shall be imposed the following fees and charges for services rendered by the Provincial Veterinary Office and Kabayan Breeding Station, to wit:

(a) **Veterinary Health Certificate Fee**

1. Carabao	P 25.00 per head
2. Cattle	25.00 per head
3. Sheep or Goat	10.00 per head
4. Swine	10.00 per head

5. Poultry products:
(a) Fancy Fowl (eg. Fighting cocks) 10.00 per head
(b) Commercial (eg. Broiler, Layer,
ducks) 0.50 per head

(b) Breeding Fees

Payment will be collected at the first service. If it fails, repeat the service without additional fees. However, if it still fails, third service will be collected in full, as follows:

SECTION 3. Imposition of Charges. There shall be collected for the sale or disposition of Calves, lambs/kids, foals, piglets, chicks, etc. produced at Kabayan Breeding Station at the current prevailing market price to be determined by the Provincial Veterinarian or his deputy.

Culled breeders shall be sold or disposed in accordance with the provisions of COA Circular No. 92-386 dated October 20, 1992 of the Commission on Audit, Quezon City.

SECTION 4. Time and Manner of payments.

(a) The fees herein imposed shall be paid to the Provincial Treasurer or his duly authorized representative upon request for the same at the Provincial Veterinary Office or at Kabayan Breeding Station.

(b) The veterinary charges shall be paid to the Provincial Treasurer or his duly authorized representative upon receipt of the Notice of Award or upon delivery of the items purchased.

(c) For this purpose, any bonded Accountable Officer/employee in the Provincial Veterinary Office may be authorized by the Provincial Treasurer to receive payment of veterinary fees and charges and issue corresponding official receipt thereon.

SECTION 4. Administrative Provisions.

(a) The Provincial Veterinarian or his assistants shall keep a record of all services conducted, copies of certificates issued, indicating the name of individuals, the dates and the kind of services rendered.

(b) The Provincial Veterinarian or his assistants shall submit a list of property or items sold or disposed of to the Provincial Treasurer and Provincial Accountant for their information and appropriate action.

SECTION 5. Penalty. Any violation of the provisions of this Article shall be punished by a fine of not less than Five Hundred (P500.00) pesos but not exceeding One Thousand (P1,000.00) pesos or imprisonment of not less than One (1) month but not exceeding six (6) months, or both, at the discretion of the Court.

Section 4. Section 1 of Article A of Chapter V shall be amended by the insertion of sub-section a-1 and shall read as follows:

(a-1) Provincial Gymnasium

- When used by persons or entities other than the activities of the Provincial Government per day or fraction thereof. P 200.00
- Boxing ring and paraphernalia including gymnasium when used by Sports promoters other than the Provincial Government , per day or fraction thereof. 1,000.00
- Boxing gloves, per pair, per bout 100.00
- Chairs and tables without table cloth per day or fractions thereof .50/pc.

Provided, that fifty (50%) percent of the amount herein realized shall be kept as Trust Fund to be expended for the maintenance and purchase of new equipment.

Section 5. Chapter V shall be amended with the insertion of ARTICLE C which shall read as follows:

Article C. Rental fees for the use of Museum artifacts, chairs, tables, potted flowering and ornamental plants.

Section 1. Imposition of Fees. There shall be collected rental fees for the use of Museum artifacts, tents, parachutes, chairs, tables, varietal seedlings, potted flowering and ornamental plants by any person/borrower at the following rates:

- a. One (1) set (6 pieces) Musical instruments consisting of one (1) solibao; one (1) Kimbal; one (1) Kalsa; one (1) pinsac; and one (1) pair palas for 24 hrs. or fraction thereof and an additional Five (P5.00) pesos for every hour thereafter. P 50.00
- b. One (1) set (3 pairs) Blankets, consisting of one (1) piece Sarong and one (1) pair tayao for 24 hrs. or fraction thereof and an additional five (P5.00) pesos for every hour thereafter. 50.00

Provided, that Fifty (50%) percent of the rental fee herein realized shall be kept as Trust Fund to be expended for the maintenance and purchase of new Musical Instruments or artifacts.

- c. Fifty (50) potted variety plants and ornamentals per day or fraction thereof. 500.00

Twenty-five (25) potted variety plants and
ornamentals per day or fraction thereof 250.00

Rental fee for lesser number shall be on a case-to-case
basis at a rate to be determined by the Provincial
Agriculturist or her duly authorized deputy.

Provided, that fifty (50%) percent of the amount herein
realized be kept as Trust Fund to be expended for the
operational expenses of Provincial demonstration farm.

Section 2. Exemption. The Provincial Government of Benguet shall be exempted from the payment of the herein rental fees.

Section 3. Time of Payment. The rental fee shall be paid to the Provincial Treasurer or his deputy upon approval by the Provincial Governor.

Section 4. Administrative Provisions.

- a. Approved application form together with the original official receipt of payment shall be presented before the release of any rented equipment, flowering and ornamental plants.
- b. Damages or losses shall be charged to the renter at a current prevailing price per evaluation.
- c. Hauling and returning of the rented equipment and plants from and to the place of origin shall be the sole responsibility of the renter/borrower.

Section 5. Penalty. Any violation of the provisions of this article shall be punished by a fine of not less than One Thousand (P1,000.00) but not more than Five Thousand (P5,000.00) pesos or imprisonment of not less than one (1) month, but not more than six (6) months or both fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court."

Section 6. Any ordinance, resolutions, administrative orders and other issuances inconsistent with the provisions of the Ordinance are hereby repealed, canceled and/or revoked.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its last date of publication or posting whichever comes late.
