PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 99-58

AN ORDINANCE SETTING "BENGUET FOUNDATION DAY" TO NOVEMBER 23 OF EVERY YEAR STARTING YEAR 2000 AND REPEALING SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN RESOLUTION NO. 269, S. 1988

WHEREAS, Act No. 49 dated November 23, 1900 established the civil government of the Province of Benguet;

WHEREAS, inserted in Act No. 155 dated June 29, 1901, is a proviso directing that a popular representative of Benguet be elected on July 4, 1901, a clear manifestation that the Province of Benguet is a separate and distinct province as early as 1900;

WHEREAS, RA 4695 dated June 18, 1966 that created the four district provinces like Benguet, Ifugao, Kalinga-Apayao and Mountain Province out of the then sub-provinces of the old Mt. Province justly restored and retrieved the original status of then Benguet Province as a distinct and separate province;

WHEREAS, the celebration of "Benguet Foundation Day" on November 23 of every year, starting Year 2000 instead of June 19 pursuant to SP Resolution No. 269, s. 1988, is truly reflective of the historical events, thereby correcting the historical inadvertency;

WHEREAS, RA 7672 declaring June 18 as non-working holiday in the Province of Benguet is enacted in recognition of its having been weaned from the old Mt. Province, hence, it is not contravened by this ordinance;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, be it

Enacted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in Session Assembled the following:

Handwritten signatures of the members of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, including the Presiding Officer and other board members, are present at the bottom of the document.

SECTION 1 - Starting year 2000, Benguet Foundation Day shall be celebrated every year on November 23.


SECTION 2 - An amount sufficient to cover the operating expenses of committees required to implement the observance of this historical event shall be appropriated every year starting 2000.

SECTION 3 - This ordinance repeals Sangguniang Panlalawigan Resolution No. 269, s. 1988, and shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication.
