
**PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 00-66**

**ORDINANCE SETTING ASIDE INCOME FROM OPERATIONS  
OF THE BENGUET GENERAL HOSPITAL UNDER A SPECIAL  
ACCOUNT IN THE GENERAL FUND TO HELP DEFRAY  
MAINTENANCE, OPERATING AND OTHER EXPENSES  
(MOOE) AND PAY PERSONAL SERVICES OF ADDITIONAL  
CASUAL PERSONNEL OF THE HEALTH FACILITY**

“WHEREAS, the Benguet General Hospital was upgraded from a 100-bed capacity into a 200-bed capacity hospital with a present work force of 167 permanent employees;

WHEREAS, increase in bed capacity correspondingly requires a maximum work force of 339 more or less or an additional personnel of 172 in order to be fully operational but the Provincial Government of Benguet could not create the needed positions because of the 45% limitation on expenditures for personnel services imposed by Section 325 (a) of RA 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the proposal to declare the Benguet General Hospital as an economic enterprise in order to do away with limitations on hiring, needs further study and scrutiny;



WHEREAS, Section 313 (c ) of the Local Government Code of 1991 allows the maintenance of Special Accounts in the General Fund stated thus;

“SEC. 313. Special Accounts to be Maintained in the General Fund Local government units shall maintain special accounts in the general fund for the following:

xxx

(c ) Development projects funded from the share of the local government unit concerned in the internal revenue allotment and such other special accounts which may be created by law or ordinance.”

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Board Member Liso L. Agpas duly seconded by Board Members Danio L. Bolislis and Manuel C. Cuilan

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Benguet in Session assembled that:

Section 1. All earnings of the Benguet General Hospital shall be set aside under a Special Account in the General Fund to be utilized to help defray Maintenance, Operating and Other Expenditures (MOOE) and to pay the personal services of additional casual personnel of the hospital.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with pertinent provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991.
