PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 04 – 92

**AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A COLLEGE EDUCATIONAL
SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR POOR BUT DESERVING STUDENTS
AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

One of the functions and duties of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan as stated under Sec. 468 (3) (IX) is to establish a scholarship fund for the poor but deserving students in schools located within its jurisdiction or for students residing within the province;

This function and duty was never implemented from the time, the Local Government Code of 1991 was enacted, hence this ordinance;

Also, the establishment of a college educational scholarship program would give poor but deserving student the chance to finish their college schooling;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN OF BENGUET,
IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, THAT:

SECTION 1. There shall be created and established a Provincial Scholarship Program for college students in the Province of Benguet which shall be known as "Benguet Provincial Scholarship Program (BPSP)". This program shall be limited to Four-year courses.

SECTION 2. The qualification for applicant student grantee shall be:

- a) Grantee is born and a bonafide resident in the Province of Benguet;
- b) Grantee must be poor but deserving student as certified by the Punong Barangay where he resides and the Office of the Municipal Social Welfare and Development;
- c) Grantee must not be more than 21 years old;
- d) Grantee must be of good moral character;
- e) Grantee must have a general average of at least 85% upon graduation from high school and must belong to the top 10 of his class as certified by the school principal or head of the school; Grantee should not have a grade below 80% in any subject;
- f) Grantee should enroll in a CHED-accredited educational institution within Baguio City and Benguet;
- g) Grantee must have attended and completed his/her elementary and high school education in the Province.

SECTION 3. A Provincial Scholarship Program Committee is hereby created to screen and select qualified students composed of the following:

- a. Chairman - Provincial Governor
- b. Members - Chairman, SP Committee on Education
- SK Federation President
- Provincial Treasurer
- PTCA Federation, President
- Liga ng mga Barangay President
- Provincial Social Welfare and Development Officer.
- PPSTA-Benguet Chapter
- Representative from the Private Schools Association

SECTION 4. There shall be two (2) grantees from each of the 13 Municipalities of the Province of Benguet per year up to a maximum of eight (8) grantees on the 4th year of implementation. Each grantee is entitled to P10,000.00/school year, provided, that the scholar grantee should obtain passing grades in all his/her enrolled subjects.

SECTION 5. The amount of P260,000.00 shall be appropriated under the general fund on the first year of implementation; P520,000.00 on the second year of implementation; P780,000.00 on the third year of implementation; and P1,040,000.00 on the fourth year of implementation. The budgetary requirement shall be incorporated in the annual provincial




budget every year to be taken from the General Fund. The amount may be increased accordingly as the need arises.

SECTION 6. The Provincial Scholarship Program Committee shall prepare the implementing rules and regulations within 90 days from the enactment of this ordinance, subject to the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991, as amended.


