**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 96-31  
GRANTING FINANCIAL INCENTIVES TO MEDAL/TROPHY WINNERS  
AND THEIR COACHES REPRESENTING THE PROVINCE  
WHO BRING HONOR AND PRESTIGE TO THE PROVINCE  
(OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE PROVINCIAL SPORTS INCENTIVE AWARD)**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

WHEREAS, there is a need to give recognition and acknowledge those who bring honor and prestige to the Province in the field of sports through the grant of financial award which shall serve as additional incentive for participants to strive for excellence and bring more medal/trophy for the Province and for others to emulate;

WHEREAS, motivation in the form of awards should be given not only to participants but also to the coach as co-achiever since a good coach-participant relationship is a key factor that will form and determine the development and success of a participant; likewise, the potential of a participant is harnessed, developed, and refined by the arduous and time-keeping task of a coach;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN OF BENGUET, IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, THAT:

SECTION 1. Winner who brings medal/trophy together and their coaches representing the Province who competes in any provincial, regional, national, or international competitions and brings home a gold, silver, or bronze medals or championship trophy, 1<sup>st</sup> runner-up, or 2<sup>nd</sup> runner-up as official winner shall be given financial or monetary reward by the Province;


SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS.

1. International Competition shall be defined as "any event/activity regardless of the venue (forum beaming an international character or nature and participated in not only by Filipinos but also delegates from other countries as well)";
2. National Competition shall be defined as any event/activity in any venue/place with the territory of the Philippines and participated in by representatives from different organizations as sanctioned by the government through any recognized government agency;
3. Regional Competition shall be defined as any event/activity held within the boundaries of the region and participated in by representatives from different organizations within the region and sanctioned by the government through any recognized government agencies;
4. Provincial Competition shall be defined as any activity/event held within the boundaries of Benguet Province and participated in by the representatives from the different organizations within the Province and sanctioned by the government through any recognized government agency;

SECTION 3. COMPETITION OR CONTEST COVERED BY THE ORDINANCE.

The following are the competition or events that shall be covered. Provided, that the medal/trophy winner who together with their coaches bring honor and prestige to the Province, and provided further, that the coaches and competitors or players are officially representing the Province, to wit:

1. Archery

SECTION 5. ADDITIONAL AWARDS. Citations or other congratulatory gestures may be given through legislative acts of Sangguniang Panlalawigan Resolution;

SECTION 6. An incentive award of P 300,000.00 shall be incorporated in the annual provincial budget and for every year thereafter. The amount shall be increased accordingly as the need arises.

SECTION 7. Winner of any of the above-mentioned medals/trophies shall personally present the same to the Provincial Sports Council through the Provincial Governor not later than sixty (60) days from award. The Provincial Governor shall then issue the necessary confirmation of the medal/trophy in favor of the winner, who shall present the same to the proper authorities for release of financial reward. Failure to present the medal/trophy to the Provincial Governor within the period as above-mentioned shall mean waiver of the reward.

SECTION 8. Any provision of existing ordinance, resolution, or any provincial issuances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

SECTION 9. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.







