PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 05-101

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 02-77
CREATING THE PROVINCIAL COUNCIL ON CULTURE AND ARTS**

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that Local Government Units play an important role in the development, promotion, and preservation of Filipino culture to encourage the participation of the people in the development and preservation of Filipino identity;

WHEREAS, Section 468 (4) (vii) of the same Code vest upon the Sangguniang Panlalawigan the power to establish a provincial council whose purpose is the promotion of culture and the arts, coordination with government agencies and non-government organizations, and subject to the availability of funds, appropriate for the support and development of the same;

WHEREAS, in order to promote the Filipino culture, instill nationhood and cultural levity, and raise the level of consciousness of the people on cultural values and conservation of historical and cultural heritage and resources, the provincial government should take an active role; and in the pursuit of these mandates, goals, and objectives, there is a need to create this council;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN OF BENGUET, IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, THAT;

Section 1. Name. PROVINCIAL COUNCIL ON CULTURE AND THE ARTS (PCCA)

Section 2. Composition.

Section 3. Functions.

1. Prepare an annual plan on culture and the arts consonant to the medium Term Philippine Development Plan for culture and the arts to be integrated in the Provincial Development Plan;
2. Formulate programs and recommendations to develop local cultural and artistic talents;
3. Protect, preserve, and conserve the local cultural and historical heritage;
4. Conduct cultural events such as cultural festivals, competitions, lectures, seminars, for a, and symposia and set up exhibits during fiestas and other related activities in coordination with the private sector;
5. Conduct periodic consultations with all stake holders or identify grassroots based cultural concerns, issues, and agenda;
6. Encourage the development of local cultural industries
7. Conduct periodic inventory of local cultural objects and sites in coordination with the National Commission for Culture and the Arts Council.
8. Coordinate with existing Local Culture and the Arts Council.

Section 4. Secretariat. The Provincial Community Affairs and Benguet Museum shall serve as head of the secretariat during meetings and act as custodian of all records of the Council.

Section 5. Meetings. The Council shall meet at least once every quarter. However, the Chairman of the Council can call special meetings as need arises.

Section 6. Per Diems. Members of the Council not otherwise barred under COA rules to claim per diems in attending meetings in Special Bodies are entitled to an amount equal to those being given by the Province.

Non-Government Organization members shall be entitled to an honorarium as allowed by law.

Section 7. Funding. An amount of One Hundred Seventy Thousand Pesos (Ph 170,000.00) shall be appropriated annually from the 20% Provincial Development Fund for the expenses and/or operation of the council.





Section 8. Separability Clause. Any portion of this ordinance that may be declared null and void or unconstitutional shall not affect the validity of the other provisions.


Section 9. Repealing Clause. Provincial Ordinance No. 02-77 and other rules and orders promulgated pursuant thereto or which are inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed or amended.

Section 10. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after posting.





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
