AMENDING SECTION 1 AND LETTER (a) OF SECTION 2 OF
PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 04-92 ENTITLED: "AN
ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A COLLEGE EDUCATIONAL
SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR POOR BUT DESERVING
STUDENTS AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF"

WHEREAS, referred to the Committee on Education is letter dated August 30, 2005 of Hon. Borromeo P. Melchor, Provincial Governor, relative to Provincial Ordinance No. 04-92 dated August 23, 2004 entitled: "An ordinance to establish a College Educational Scholarship Program for poor but deserving students and appropriating funds thereof" with the following observations, to wit:

During the information and the selection of applicants, the Scholarship Committee has received various feedbacks, comments, recommendations which all points that some particular items be incorporated in the ordinance. Coupled with our observation, we came up with some recommended items to be incorporated in the Ordinance, which are:

Section 1. There shall be created and establish a Provincial Scholarship Program for college students in the Province of Benguet which shall be known as "Benguet Provincial Scholarship Program (BPSP)". This Program shall be limited to *Four-year courses or Five-year courses.*

In addition, the item Five-year courses is premised on the fact that most of the student grantees have enrolled in B.S. Engineering, B.S. Accountancy and Veterinary medicine, which are all Five-year courses.

Section 2. The qualification for applicant student grantee shall be:

- a) Grantee is born and a bonafide resident in the Province of Benguet with *either parent belonging to any of the ethnic tribe of Benguet.*

Handwritten signatures and initials in blue ink are present on the right side and bottom of the page, including a large signature on the right margin and several smaller ones at the bottom.

The membership to an ethnic tribe be speaks of a scholarship unique to Benguet though it might be misinterpreted as selective. Most of the members of the ethnic tribe deserves this kind of scholarship.

NOW THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN OF BENGUET THAT;

SECTION 1 - Section 1 and letter (a) Section 2 of Provincial Ordinance No. 04-92 entitled: "An ordinance to establish a College Educational Scholarship Program for poor but deserving students and appropriating funds thereof" is amended to read, viz:

"Section 1. There shall be created and established a Provincial Scholarship Program for college students in the Province of Benguet which shall be known as "Benguet Provincial Scholarship Program (BPSP)". This Program shall be limited to Four-year courses or Five-year courses.

In addition of the item Five-year courses is premised on the fact that most of the student grantees have enrolled in B.S. Engineering, B.S. Accountancy and Veterinary medicine, which are all Five-year courses.

Section 2. The qualification for applicant student grantee shall be:

- a) Grantee is born and a bonafide resident in the Province of Benguet with either parent belonging to any of the ethnic tribe of Benguet."


SECTION 2 - This ordinance shall take effecting in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991.






