**PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 06-109**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 05-107 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE BENGUET REVENUE CODE OF 2005**

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to amend certain sections of Provincial Tax Ordinance No. 05-107 otherwise known as the Benguet Revenue Code of 2005 for purposes of clarity.

**NOW THEREFORE**, on motion duly seconded, be it

**ORDAINED** by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled that :

**SECTION 1. Amendments.** The following sections of the Benguet Revenue Code of 2005 are hereby amended as follows :

- a) Section 8 of Article One, Chapter 2 shall read as

**Realty Tax Rates on Equipment and Machinery.** There is hereby levied a two ( 2 ) percent tax on the *assessed value* of civil works, equipment, machinery and other improvements of a registered mini-hydro electric power developer. Of this two (2) percent one (1) percent shall accrue to the basic tax and other one (1) percent to the Special Education Fund.

- b) Section 37 (a), Article Five (**Tax on Transfer of Real Property Ownership**), Chapter 2 shall read as

**Section 37.(a) Administrative Provisions.**

The Register of Deeds of the province shall, before registering any deed, require the presentation of the evidence of payment of this tax. The Provincial/Municipal Assessor shall likewise make the same requirement before canceling an old tax declaration and issuing a new one. *In addition thereto, a certification of non-tax delinquency shall also be required before the cancellation of the old tax declaration.*

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**SECTION 2. Effectivity.** This ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 2006.
