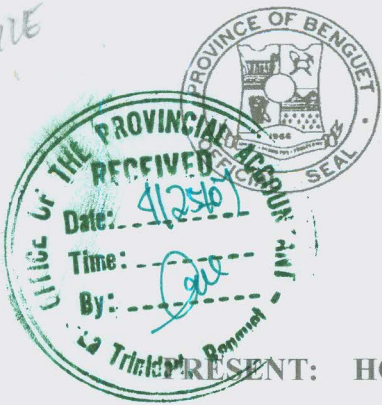

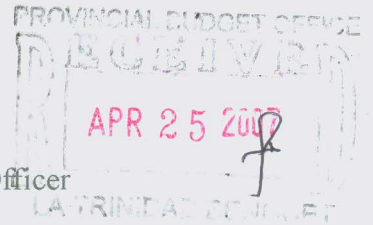

PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 07-117

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A FEE TO BE COLLECTED FROM INTERNET USERS AT THE BENGUET PROVINCIAL LIBRARY

EXPLANATORY NOTE

“WHEREAS, forwarded to the august Body is 1 Endorsement dated February 22, 2007 of Hon. Borromeo P. Melchor, Provincial Governor transmitting letter dated February 19, 2007 of the Provincial Treasurer, Mrs. Imelda I. Macanes, requesting that an ordinance be enacted for the imposition of a fee from internet users at the Benguet Provincial Library;

WHEREAS, Section 132 of the Local Government Code provides that “The power to impose a tax, fee, or charge or to generate revenue under this Code shall be exercised by the sanggunian of the local government unit concerned through an appropriate ordinance;

On motion duly seconded, be it

ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN OF THE PROVINCE OF BENGUET IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, THAT:

Section 1. Imposition of Fees. – There shall be collected a fee of Ten Pesos per hour (PhP 10.00/hr) from internet users at the Benguet Provincial Library;

Section 2. Time and Manner of Payment – The fee imposed shall be paid in full at the Revenue and Land Tax Division of the Provincial Treasurer’s Office by the user;

Section 3. Exemptions –The Officials and employees of the Provincial Government of Benguet availing of the internet services in the performance of their official functions shall be exempted from payment of the imposed rental fee.

Handwritten signatures and initials at the bottom of the page.

Section 4. Separability Clause- If for any reason, any section or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid by competent authority, such judgment or action shall not affect or impair the other provisions or sections thereof.

Section 5. – Applicability Clause- All other matters relating to the imposition in this ordinance shall be governed by pertinent provisions of existing laws and other ordinances.

Section 6. Repealing Clause- All ordinances, resolutions, executive orders, rules and regulations, or part thereof, in conflict with, or inconsistent with any provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991.


