PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 07 - 120

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 04-92 WHICH ESTABLISHED A COLLEGE EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR POOR BUT DESERVING STUDENTS AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF

EXPLANATORY NOTE

One of the functions and duties of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan as stated under Sec. 468 (4) (iv) of the Local Government Code is to establish a scholarship fund for the poor but deserving students in schools located within its jurisdiction or for students residing within the Province;

In line with such function, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan passed in 2004 an Ordinance No. 04-92 which is now in its third year of implementation;

There is however a clamor among the constituents to increase the number of scholars in each municipality from two (2) to four (4) and increase of allowance or assistance from Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) to Six Thousand Pesos (P6,000.00) which requires an increase in its budgetary requirement to address this clamor and aspiration of the constituents there is a need to amend Ordinance No. 04-92;

Also, the establishment of a college educational scholarship program would give poor but deserving students the chance to finish their college schooling;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN OF BENGUET IN SESSION ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. Section IV of Provincial Ordinance No. 04-92 is hereby amended to read as follows:


“Section IV. There shall be four (4) grantees from each of the thirteen (13) Municipalities of the Province of Benguet per year. Each grantee is entitled to Twelve Thousand Pesos (P12,000.00) per school year, provided that the scholar-grantee should obtain passing grades in all his/her enrolled subjects”

SECTION 2. Section V of the Provincial Ordinance No. 04-92 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Section V. The amount of P1,560,000.00 shall be appropriated under the general fund for the Fiscal Year 2008; P2,184,000.00 for Fiscal Year 2009; P2,496,000.00 for Fiscal Year 2010; and P2,808,000.00 for Fiscal Year 1011. The budgetary requirement shall be incorporated in the annual provincial budget every year to be taken from the General Fund. The amount may be increased accordingly as the need arises.”


SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991, as amended.


