Provincial Ordinance No. 08-129

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 02-77, AS AMENDED BY PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 05-101 CREATING THE PROVINCIAL COUNCIL ON CULTURE AND THE ARTS

WHEREAS, Provincial Ordinance No. 02-77 as amended by Provincial Ordinance No. 05-101 created the Provincial Council on Culture and Arts;

WHEREAS, there is a need to revise the composition of the council in order to enhance the participation of the various sectors, particularly the Indigenous Peoples Organizations in this province;

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan that:

Section 1. Name of Council. It shall be known as the Provincial Council for Culture and the Arts (PCCA);

Section 2. Composition. The PCCA shall composed of the following

Chairman	Provincial Governor
Vice- Chairman	Provincial Vice Governor
Co-Vice Chairman	SP Committee Chairman on Tourism, Culture and the Arts

Members:

1. SP Chairman, Committee on Indigenous Peoples
2. Representative, Provincial Planning & Development Office
3. Representative, Provincial Budget Office
4. Representative, Provincial Tourism Office
5. Representative, Benguet Provincial Tourism Council
6. Representative, Benguet Provincial Library

Section 3. Functions.

1. Prepare an annual plan on culture and the arts consonant to the medium Terms Philippine Development Plan for culture and the arts to be integrated in the Provincial Development Plan;
2. Formulate programs and recommendations to develop local cultural and artistic talents;
3. Protect, preserve, and conserve the local cultural and historical heritage;
4. Conduct cultural events such as cultural festivals, competitions, lectures, seminars, fora, and symposia and set up exhibits during fiestas and other related activities in coordination with the private sector;
5. Conduct periodic consultations with all stake holders or identify grassroots based cultural concerns, issues, and agenda;
6. Encourage the development of local cultural industries;
7. Conduct periodic inventory of local cultural objects and sites in coordination with the National Commission for Culture and the Arts; and
8. Coordinate with existing Local Culture and the Arts Council.

Section 4. Secretariat. The Provincial Library Office shall serve as Secretariat during meetings and act as custodian of all records of the Council.

Section 5. Meetings. The Council shall meet at least once every quarter. However, the Chairman of the Council can call special meetings as need arises.

Section 6. Per Diems. Members of the Council not otherwise barred under COA rules to claim per diems in attending meetings in Special Bodies are entitled to an amount equal to those being given by the Province.

Non-Government Organization members shall be entitled to an honorarium as allowed by law.

Section 7. Funding. An amount of One Hundred Seventy Thousand (Ph 170,000.00) shall be appropriated annually from the 20% Provincial Development Fund for the expenses and/or operation of the Council.

Section 8. Separability Clause. Any portion of this ordinance that may be declared null and void or unconstitutional shall not affect the validity of the other provisions.

Section 9. Repealing Clause. Provincial Ordinance No. 02-77, as amended by Provincial Ordinance No. 05-101 are hereby repealed or amended.
