PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 10 - 140

AMENDING SECTION 6 OF PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 04-93 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE ENACTING A SENIOR CITIZENS OFFICER FOR A DAY AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF"

WHEREAS, Provincial Ordinance No. 04-93 dated August 23, 2004 was enacted primarily to put recognition on the dynamic and active involvement of the Senior Citizens of the Province of Benguet to convert their wisdom and visions (heritage, cultural and historical) to policy directives of the Province;

WHEREAS, in the said Ordinance, particularly Section 6 thereof, nominated senior Citizens are allowed to occupy the elective positions of the Province from the Governor to the members of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for a day during the Senior Citizens Official For A Day (SCOFAD) every year as institutionalized practice;

WHEREAS, during the SCOFAD on October 4, 2010, the Senior Citizens For A Day (SCOFAD) requested thru Resolution No. 10-007 for the amendment of Section 7, which properly should be Section 6, in such a way that a Senior Citizen shall be nominated to sit as Provincial SCOFAD Official to only once in order to allow others the opportunity to be nominated in the succeeding year;

WHEREAS, the SCOFAD's request is with merit, for the reason that to allow members to occupy the aforesaid positions under Section 3 to once only in their life time will effect the equal participation of the other members in articulating and crafting their noble visions and wisdom into policies for effective governance;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN OF BENGUET, IN SESSION ASSEMBLED THAT:

Section 1. That Section 6 of Provincial Ordinance No. 04-93 which provides that "The nomination process for the officers will be done in the Municipal Federation level selecting One (1) Nominee. The first Two (2) Municipalities with the highest number of Senior Citizens shall have Two (2) Nominees" shall be amended to finally read as follows:

“Section 6. The nomination process for the officers will be done in the Municipal Federation Level selecting One (1) Nominee. The first Two (2) Municipalities with the highest number of Senior Citizens shall have Two (2) Nominees. The qualified Members from any of the Municipal Federation of Senior Citizens shall be nominated only once for the purpose of this Ordinance.

Section 2. That the Amending Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
