PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 11-146

AN ORDINANCE REVISING THE COURSES OFFERED AND THE CORRESPONDING TUITION FEES PROVIDED FOR UNDER ARTICLE 6, SECTION 107 OF THE BENGUET REVENUE CODE OF 2005 AS AMENDED BY PROVINCIAL TAX ORDINANCE NO. 08-126 AND PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 10-137

WHEREAS, Section 1 of the Provincial Tax Ordinance No. 08-126 which amended Article 6, Section 107 of the Benguet Revenue Code Provides:

"Section 1. Section 107 of the Provincial Tax Ordinance No. 05-107 of the Province of Benguet shall be amended as follows:

WHEREAS, Section 1 of Provincial Tax Ordinance was further amended by Provincial Ordinance No. 10-137 to include in the courses offered the Nihonggo Language Classes with the corresponding number of hours and tuition fee, to wit:

WHEREAS, the Benguet Technical School has been yearly updating its equipment and courses with TESDA training standards which has jurisdiction and supervision over vocational and technical schools;

WHEREAS, the nomenclatures of the different courses offered by BTS do not conform to the nomenclatures in the Standard Training Regulations of TESDA and the present tuition fees are much lower as compared to other vocational and technical schools in the Province;

WHEREAS, there is a need to revise the Course Titles being offered at BTS to conform with the existing Program Titles in the Competency-Based Training Regulations of TESDA with the revision of tuition fees on account of the upgraded curriculum in accordance to TESDA training standard and compliance of tools and equipment as required under the Unified TVET Program Registration and Accreditation System of TESDA;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled that:

Section 1. Article 6, Section 107 of Provincial Tax Ordinance No. 08-126 shall be revised as follows:

SECTION 2. Discounts. Students who enrolled two (2) courses simultaneously in the same semester shall be given discounts of ten percent (10%) off on their tuition fee of the second course and non-payment of miscellaneous fees for Registration Fee, School ID, and Group Insurance;

SECTION 3. Separability Clause. If, for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, other sections or provisions thereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect

Section 4. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991, as amended. Further, the application of the tuition fee increase will be in a staggered basis, that is, the first 50% of the increase shall be effective on the first semester of S.Y. 2011-2012 and the second and final 50% of the increase shall be effective on the second semester S.Y. 2011-2012, as illustrated in Section 1 hereof;

Let this ordinance be forwarded to the Provincial Governor, for his information and appropriate action. Furnish a copy hereof also to Ms. Yolanda E. Olano, Regional Director, TESDA-CAR, Ms. Angela E. Gabriel, Provincial Director, TESDA-Benguet, Miss Flora P. Manuel, BTS Administrator, the Provincial Budget Officer, Provincial Accountant, and Provincial Treasurer, all for their information.
