PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 14-168

AN ORDINANCE CONFERRING AWARDS TO DESERVING INDIVIDUALS OR ENTITIES DURING THE FOUNDATION ANNIVERSARY OF THE PROVINCE OF BENGUET

EXPLANATORY NOTE

WHEREAS, the Province of Benguet celebrates its foundation anniversary as a civil government in the month of November of every year;

WHEREAS, one of the main highlights of the yearly celebration should be the recognition of individuals or entities who demonstrated leadership qualities or achievements or accomplishments worthy of emulation and have projected a good image of the province or have voluntarily rendered social, economic and infrastructure services benefiting the province;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN OF
BENGUET THAT:**

Section 1. Short Title of the Ordinance: This Ordinance shall be known as the "Benguet Awards Ordinance";

Section 2. Awards Committee: There shall be an Awards Committee to be created and the members of which are to be designated by the Provincial Governor.

Section 3. Functions of the Awards Committee:

1. To prepare guidelines for nominations;
2. To select awardees in various categories in accordance with the criteria provided herein and after proper verification;
3. To prepare write-ups for the Awardees to be presented during the Awards ceremony;
4. To coordinate the preparation of plaques and rings with the Provincial General Services Officer;
5. To present list of proposed awardees to the Governor for approval

Section 4. Criteria for each Category of Award:

A. Benguet Leadership Awards:

1. Awardee must be a natural born citizen of the Province.
2. Awardee must have demonstrated qualities of leadership in any field with outstanding achievement/accomplishments projecting good image for the province internationally, nationally or regionally.
3. Awardee must be a living individual
4. Awardee must not have previously been given the same category of award by the province.
5. Must not be incumbent elective official of the province.

B. Everlasting Award:

1. Awardee may either be an individual or an entity.
2. Awardee must have voluntarily rendered social, economic and infrastructure services benefiting the province or two or more municipalities and/or its people.
3. Awardee must not have previously been given the same category of award.

C. Achievement Awards:

1. Awardee may be either living or dead individual or an entity.
2. Awardee must have outstanding action worthy of emulation in a specific field of endeavor thus projecting a good image for the province or the people of Benguet regionally, nationally or internationally.

3. A natural born or resident /domicile of the province for at least ten (10) years.
4. Must not have previously been given the same category of award

D. Outstanding Student Leadership Award:

1. Awardee must be a living individual and currently enrolled in any school;
2. Awardee must be a natural born citizen of the province;
3. Awardee must have demonstrated qualities of leadership in any field with outstanding achievements/accomplishments projecting a good image for the province internationally, nationally and regionally; and
4. Awardee must not have previously been given the same category of award by the province.

Section 5. Awards. For the Leadership awards, the awardee shall be given an 18 Karat Gold Ring and a plaque; for the Everlasting, Achievement and Outstanding Student Leadership awards, the awardees shall be given plaques of appreciation.

Section 6. Per Diems or Honorarium shall be given to the Awards Committee Members who are non-government employees or officials subject to the usual accounting, auditing rules and regulations.

Section 7. Source of Funds: The total amount of two hundred fifty thousand pesos (P250, 000.00) shall be made available every Calendar Year in the General Fund of the Province for the implementation of this ordinance.

Section 8. Repealing Clause: All existing ordinances or decrees not in conformity with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 9. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


